Message from Guide Tim Winslow: “These late seasons bear hunts can have a wide variety of conditions and we can always take layers off, but we need to be ready for all conditions!”

Clothing

- ☐ Pack all clothes in Sea Summit Waterproof Cinch Dry **Stuff Sack**
 - Allows compression; You can use your stuff sack as a pillow
- ☐ 5-7 Pairs of **Wool Socks**
 - Darn Tough Hunting Heavy*
- ☐ 1-2 **Baselayer sets** (top and bottom), Wool or Synthetic
 - Origin Nano Wool Set*
- ☐ 1 Polar Fleece **Midweight Jacket**
 - Sitka Bluff Berber*
 - Origin Stealth Wool Jacket*
- ☐ **Windproof Pants / Bottoms**
 - Sitka Windstopper Timberline*
- ☐ **Mid-Weight Down Puffer** to stuff in your backpack
- ☐ **Neck and Face Gaiter** Fleece
- ☐ **Winter Hat** Beanie Wool or Synthetic
- ☐ **Rain Gear**
 - Helly Hansen Rain Jacket & Pant*
 - Sitka Rain Gear*
- ☐ Waterproof Insulated **Gloves**
 - Hestra claw mitten*
- ☐ **Leg Gaiters**
 - OR brand Gore Tex*
- ☐ Quality **Hiking Boots** *Please break in Boots*
 - Lathrop and Sons (Mink oil wax prior to trip)*
- ☐ **Hip Waders** that fit correctly
 - Simms Pant/Chest Waders with Boots*

Hunting Equipment

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| ☐ Rifle: 30 Cal preferable with quality 3-9 or 4-16 scope | ☐ Archery: Bow know the legal requirements for moose with poundage and broadhead size |
| ☐ Allen Keys: to repair or tighten scope mounts | ☐ Release x2 |
| ☐ Sling: Claw | ☐ Allen set to readjust/fix the sight etc. |
| ☐ 1 box of ammo 20Rds | ☐ Arrows: 1 dozen |
| | ☐ Broadhead: slick trick/g5 stryker/muzzy |

Notes:

Temperatures range from **0-50°** Fahrenheit, **layering under a waterproof jacket is a must**

** Indicates guide recommended but other brands will do. If you bring a few things extra that's ok but don't over-pack.*

*** Ensure to bring extra medication/ necessities in the case of being weathered in. For a 10 day trip, we recommend you bring 15+ day's worth*

**** It is illegal for us to sell liquor as Iliamna is a damp village by law and alcohol/tobacco products are hard to find or unavailable in most areas of the Alaskan bush. That said, we would like you to enjoy your vacation. If you want these items, bring them from home or buy them in Anchorage before heading to Iliamna. Anchorage liquor stores box and label your spirits free of charge. Alternatively, you can place an order with Brown Jug Liquor online with delivery to Talarik Creek Lodge. Shipping times to rural Alaska can be lengthy, so be sure to plan ahead. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, and are happy to assist you with pre-ordering alcohol. We have a variety of mixers available for our guests at the lodge.*

***** Cash or cashiers cheque for your guide(s). Gratuity is usually 10-20% of hunt cost paid at the end of your trip, separate from trip cost (which must be paid in full before arrival). Please do not forget gratuity for the pilots and lodge staff to show your appreciation for their effort towards your trip's successes, comfort, and enjoyment.*
