Clothing

- ☐ Pack all clothes in Sea Summit Waterproof Cinch Dry **Stuff Sack**
 - Allows compression; You can use your stuff sack as a pillow
- ☐ 5-7 Pairs of **Wool Socks**
 - Darn Tough Hunting Heavy*
- ☐ 1-2 **Baselayer sets** (top and bottom), Wool or Synthetic
 - Origin Nano Wool Set*
- ☐ 1 Polar Fleece **Midweight Jacket**
 - Sitka Bluff Berber*
 - Origin Stealth Wool Jacket*
- ☐ **Windproof Pants / Bottoms**
 - Sitka Windstopper Timberline*
- ☐ **Mid-Weight Down Puffer** to stuff in your backpack
- ☐ **Rain Gear**
 - Helly Hansen Rain Jacket and Pant*
 - Sitka Rain Gear*
- ☐ **Winter Hat** Beanie Wool or Synthetic
- ☐ **Neck and Face Gator** Fleece

- ☐ Thick Winter Boots Insulated, heavy boots, not hiking boots; Please break in ahead of your trip

- ☐ Oversized Insulated **Mittens** (best with removable liner), work gloves & liner
 - Rubber Waterman Gloves with removable liners*

*** Ensure to bring extra medication/ necessities in the case of being weathered in. For a 10 day trip, we recommend you bring 15+ day's worth*

**** It is illegal for us to sell liquor as Iliamna is a damp village by law and alcohol/tobacco products are hard to find or unavailable in most areas of the Alaskan bush. That said, we would like you to enjoy your vacation. If you want these items, bring them from home or buy them in Anchorage before heading to Iliamna. Anchorage liquor stores box and label your spirits free of charge. Alternatively, you can place an order with Brown Jug Liquor online with delivery to Talarik Creek Lodge. Shipping times to rural Alaska can be lengthy, so be sure to plan ahead. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, and are happy to assist you with pre-ordering alcohol. We have a variety of mixers available for our guests at the lodge.*

***** Cash or cashiers cheque for your guide(s). Gratuity is usually 10-20% of hunt cost paid at the end of your trip, separate from trip cost (which must be paid in full before arrival). Please do not forget gratuity for the pilots and lodge staff to show your appreciation for their effort towards your trip's successes, comfort, and enjoyment.*
